Figure 3-1: Attawapiskat First Nation Distribution of Communication

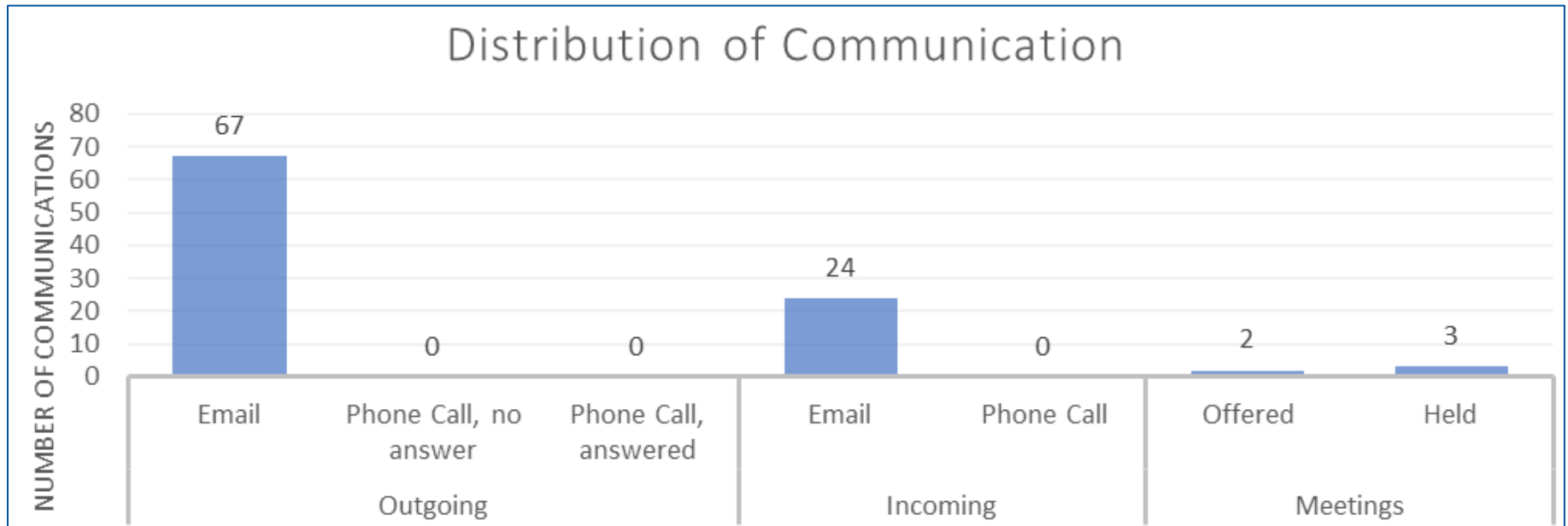
